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Specialized Activities

Registration Policy

Your registration is complete when we have the summer 2015 registration form and non-refundable deposit. Please register at least two weeks before each camp or call the camp office for availability if camp is less than two weeks away.

Payment:

Your non-refundable deposit is due with your registration for each camp. The remaining balance is due at the beginning of the camp. We process credit cards on-site at registration.

Registration Confirmation:

We will confirm your registration in the mail with a letter after we receive your completed form. We will notify you of any balance due and include any forms you need to complete and bring with you to camp.

Check In and Check Out:

Arrival time for day camps and Jubilee Camp is 9:00 am. Arrival times for all other camps are between 3:30-5 pm. You are invited to join us for the closing programs at the end of each camp session after which we ask that you sign your camper out with the appropriate staff member.



Discounts and Promotions

Family Members Discount:

After the first child who comes to camp pays in full, each additional child who attends camp from the same family will receive a 10% discount off the registration price of any session of equal or lesser cost.

Early Bird Discount:

Campers registered for day camp by April 30 will receive a \$5 discount. Campers registered for all other camps by this date will receive a \$10 discount.

Clergy Discount:

Children of clergy receive a 20% discount.



Refund Policy

1. Deposits are non-transferable and non-refundable.
2. If a camper has arrived, but needs to leave early, a refund is available. It will be total fee paid, minus the deposit, and then pro-rated.
