The following list of medications may be administered for the sign/symptoms indicated on the medication label by Park River Bible Camp Health Care Staff:

Acetaminophen 325 mg & 500 mg CalaGel-Medicated Anti-itch gels for poison ivy

Jr. Strength Acetaminophen Calamine Lotion

Biofreeze Aloe Vera Gel

Ibuprofen 200 mg Eye Wash- Eye irrigation solution

Loratidine 10 mg Cortaid Cooling Spray

Diphenhydramine 25 mg Sting Relief

Children's Benadryl Fire Ant Sting Relief

Benadryl Spray- Anti-Itch relief Triple Antibiotic Ointment

Lanacaine Spray or Cream Hydrocortisone cream 1%

Robitussin CF- Cough/chest/nasal Gold Bond Medicated Powder

Cough Drops (sugar-free) Nexcare Spray Liquid Bandage

Pseudoephedrine (sudafed), give with New Skin Liquid bandage

Claritin for cold and congestion symptoms Orajel
