Acetaminophen 325 mg & 500 mg	CalaGel-Medicated Anti-itch gels for poison ivy
Jr. Strength Acetaminophen	Calamine Lotion
Biofreeze	Aloe Vera Gel
Ibuprofen 200 mg	Eye Wash- Eye irrigation solution
Loratidine 10 mg	Cortaid Cooling Spray
Diphenhydramine 25 mg	Sting Relief
Children's Benadryl	Fire Ant Sting Relief
Benadryl Spray- Anti-Itch relief	Triple Antibiotic Ointment
Lanacaine Spray or Cream	Hydrocortisone cream 1%
Robitussin CF- Cough/chest/nasal	Gold Bond Medicated Powder
Cough Drops (sugar-free)	Nexcare Spray Liquid Bandage
Pseudoephedrine (sudafed), <i>give with</i>	New Skin Liquid bandage
<i>Claritin for cold and congestion symptoms</i>	Orajel
Sepasoothe – Anesthetic Throat	Epipen- For emergency use only
Lozenges Tums	Oxygen administration
Rolaids-Multisymptom	Ivy X Pre-contact for poison ivy
Swim Ear	Aqua ears
Tecnu Skin Cleanser (for poison ivy and oak	Jr. strength Advil
Alcohol Prep	Antiseptic wipes
Children's liquid Tylenol
