

Job Description: Maintenance Crew Leader

Qualifications:

- Be at least 21 years of age.
- Confessed faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Lifestyle consistent with that of a follower of Christ, as communicated by Holy Scriptures.
- Commitment to the Holy Scriptures as the only source and rule of doctrine, faith, and life.
- Desire and willingness to show Christian love to all people especially youth.
- Enjoys engaging youth of all ages in discussion and play time.
- Ability to work cooperatively with other staff and volunteers.
- Flexibility to adapt to various situations and needs of the camp. Job responsibilities may change at the discretion of the Director of Ministries, according to the needs of the ministry of the camp.
- Ability to use and teach people to use riding mowers, golf carts, and other small engine items.

Responsible to:

- Directly responsible to the Director of Ministries.

Responsibilities:

- Direct and assist the maintenance crew in the following areas
 - Cleaning bathrooms and public areas (Dining Hall, Gym, Chapel, etc.).
 - Maintaining the camp grounds (lawn mowing, weed whipping, etc.).
 - Minor to moderate maintenance projects (fencing, planting trees, painting)
- Provide leadership and direction to the maintenance crew and Friday cleanup crews for end of the week camp cleanup and end of the summer cleanup.
- Occasionally help lead all-camp games and provide visual coverage of campers.
- Able to assist campers in emergency (fire, injury, etc.); possess strength and endurance to do moderate lifting, digging, loading, etc. alone and heaving lifting with assistance.
- Encourage campers in the Christian faith by conveying a welcoming attitude and joyful spirit.
- Maintain a clean and safe living area.

Responsibilities of PRBC:

- Train Maintenance Crew Leader in the safe handling and proper use of cleaning products, proper operation of power tools (as needed), theology, safety procedures, activities to be led, and general camp operations in accordance with ACA standards.
- Provide a cash stipend, meals and housing as agreed upon in the Summer Staff Agreement.
- Evaluate job performance and provide encouragement.
- Supervise and assist Maintenance Crew Leader in various activities and responsibilities.
